It was once again a good month south of Northaven with no incidents reported. North of Northaven there were two related incidents. First was a robbery of an individual in the 3800 block of Palos Verdas around 12:30 in the afternoon. The resident met a stranger at the bus stop and invited him back to his home. Once there, a fight broke out and the suspect hit the resident and stole his cell phone and a case of beer. The second incident occurred at approximately 1:55 in the 3800 block of Shady Hill. The same two men met and the suspect stole bus fare from the resident. The suspect was gone before the police could get there. No comment.

The burglary of a commercial property at the shopping center occurred at 5:00 p.m. at a retail store on Marsh. No forced entry – it must have been during business hours.

We had the quarterly District 13 crime watch meeting Wednesday night. Overall crime was actually down in our area (NW DPD within District 13) from 2019 to 2020. Non-violent crime was off 4% and violent crime off 6%. In fact, violent crime is a bit skewed because 11 of the 43 reported aggravated assaults occurred in one incident (drive by shooting on Goodyear Christmas morning. 11 people were at a party. None were injured but it was recorded as 11 separate assaults).

Be sure you are using the **NO SOLICITING NO ADVERTISING** signs and stickers that are available through NPNA. We now have a good supply at a cost recovery of \$10. Signs to go on your stake are \$8.

**OUT OF TOWN**—Request the local Dallas Police NW Beat Officers to check your residence while you are away. Remember they patrol 24/7, and it is **free**. Just call 214-670-6178 a few days prior to leaving to request the service. You can also call the NW **NPO** 214-670-6206.
