North of Northaven there was a burglary of a motor vehicle in Section 1 in the 3700 block of Palos Verdas Drive. The unknown suspect entered the locked motor vehicle without damaging it and took property. This offense occurred at approximately 9:37 p.m. on February 8th. Section 1 is the closest part of the NPNA to the shopping center.

There was one burglary of commercial property at the shopping center. The Famous Footwear was broken into at 12:00 a.m. on February 16, 2021. A window was broken and property taken.

South of Northaven, a "Theft of a Motor Vehicle" was reported at 7:30 p.m. on February 11th in Section 6 in the 11200 block of Rosser Road. The vehicle was not actually stolen, just the tire rims. I say "just", but rims are expensive and the perpetrators of this type of theft are typically very professional in their process. The vehicle is up on blocks with no rims in a matter of minutes.

The investigations of all three incidents noted above are now listed as "suspended", meaning they are at a dead end.

Be sure you are using the NO SOLICITING NO ADVERTISING signs and stickers that are available through NPNA. We now have a good supply at a cost recovery of \$10 (including stake).
